Commercial Tobacco is a Racial Justice Issue

Did you know that for decades the tobacco industry has been strategically targeting minority communities? Within the past few decades, people from minority communities have been aggressively targeted to use tobacco products. Some of these targeting methods, include sponsored events, extensive promotions, and advertising campaigns. The tobacco industry determines these communities as "easy to reach" and "undermarketed."

On April 29, 2022, the Food & Drug Administration announced its commitment to remove menthol cigarettes and all flavored cigars from the market. While this announcement is encouraging, it will be a long uphill battle and it's essential for tribal communities and leadership to continue the progression to protect their youngest tribal members. Every day there are thousands who uses their first commercial tobacco product and that's an issue. As life-saving decisions are made, younger generations are less at risk to develop nicotine addiction. In addition, as change continues there is a reduction in health inequities.

Kids for Smoke-Free Air Challenge

The <u>Kids for Smoke-Free Air Challenge</u> (KFSFC) is a four (4) week program geared to educate youth in third through sixth grade about the dangers of secondhand smoke exposure in homes and vehicles. The program teaches the youth about the dangers of smoking in homes and vehicles pose, while presenting them with the challenge of collecting signatures of adults who pledge to keep their homes and cars smoke-free. By keeping these spaces smoke-free, the youth, their family, and friends are all able to breathe, clean air, safe from the dangers of second- and thirdhand smoke.

Youth organizations and clubs who participate have an opportunity to earn money for their programs as well. When the challenge has concludes, the youth program is thrown an award presentation to recognize the children's hard work and important members of the community are invited to help celebrate.

The challenge is to bring awareness of the dangers associated with secondhand smoke. There is no safe level of exposure to secondhand smoke. Those dangers include, but are not limited to:

- ♦ Increased risk of illness, as lung growth is impacted from secondhand smoke inhalation, and cases of ear infections, bronchitis and pneumonia occur more often.
- ♦ Irritation of the eyes and lungs; leading to watery eyes and sever coughing or wheezing.
- ♦ Risk of frequent and more serious asthma attacks.
- ♦ Increased likelihood of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS).

Smoke Free Signals has partnered with the Nicotine Use Prevention and Control program to host the KFSFAC for the Isleta Youth Wellness Program. The youth of the program are ecstatic to participate and raise money for thier program. Smoke Free Signals is interested in hosting the KFSFAC with another group/program in hopes of continuing to spread awareness of secondhand smoke exposure and engaging the youth of New Mexico communities.
