More than half of Americans at risk from unhealthy air



The 2016 "State of the Air" report, released on April 20 by the American Lung Association, finds that despite continued improvement in air quality, 166 million Americans (52.1 percent) are at risk from health effects of unhealthy air.

This 17th annual, national air quality report card found that unhealthy air puts more than half of all Americans at risk for premature death and other serious health effects like lung cancer, asthma attacks, cardiovascular damage and developmental and reproductive harm.
